

DOGS

We have received several complaints recently from residents who are upset about finding dog feces in their yard and even on the driveway.

Here is the paragraph governing pets in this neighborhood.

No Owner or Occupant may keep any animals other than a reasonable number of generally recognized household pets in the Community, as determined in the sole discretion of the Board of Directors. All pets maintained in the Community shall be registered, licensed and inoculated to the extent required under law. No Owner or Occupant may keep, breed or maintain any pet for any commercial purpose in the Community. **Dogs must be kept on a leash and be under the physical control of a responsible person at all times while outdoors in areas that are not fully enclosed by a fence. Feces left by pets on the Common Property or on any Lot must be removed promptly by the owner of the pet or the person responsible for the pet.**

Part of living in a neighborhood involves being kind and considerate of your neighbors. Please do your part with your pets, including paying attention when your dog is outside in your backyard barking incessantly.
